The ESCI has supported priorities and activities set out in the European Education Area (EEA), Digital Education Action Plan, Erasmus+ Initiative and European Strategy for Universities.

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European Student Card Initiative

REGULATION (EU) 2021/817 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 20 May 2021 establishing Erasmus+ the Union Programme for education and training, youth and sport and repealing Regulation (EU) No 1288/2013

(27) In line with the vision of a true European Education Area, the Programme should also boost learning mobility and exchanges and promote the participation of higher education students in educational and cultural and sports activities by supporting the digitalisation of processes through, for example, the European Student Card initiative. In this context, the Commission should develop the European Student Card initiative, in particular for higher education students participating in the Programme. The European Student Card initiative could be an important step in making learning mobility for all a reality, enabling higher education institutions to send and receive more higher education students for the purpose of exchanges while still enhancing quality in the learning mobility of higher education students, and also facilitating their access to various services, such as libraries, transport and accommodation, before their physical arrival at the institution abroad.

And art. 6 d

In the field of education and training, the Programme shall support the following actions under key action 2:

(d) user-friendly online platforms and tools for virtual cooperation, including support services for eTwinning and for the Electronic Platform for Adult Learning in Europe, and tools to facilitate learning mobility, including the European Student Card initiative.

(27) Zgodnie z wizją prawdziwego europejskiego obszaru edukacji Program powinien również poszerzać mobilność edukacyjną i wymiany oraz promować uczestnictwo studentów w działaniach edukacyjnych i kulturalnych oraz sportowych poprzez wspieranie cyfryzacji procedur poprzez, na przykład, inicjatywę dotyczącą europejskiej karty studenta. W tym kontekście Komisja powinna rozwijać inicjatywę dotyczącą europejskiej karty studenta, zwłaszcza dla studentów uczestniczących w Programie. Inicjatywa dotycząca europejskiej karty studenta może być ważnym krokiem w urzeczywistnianiu mobilności edukacyjnej dla wszystkich poprzez umożliwienie instytucjom szkolnictwa wyższego wysyłania i przyjmowania większej liczby studentów w ramach wymiany, przy jednoczesnym dalszym podnoszeniu jakości mobilności edukacyjnej studentów, a także poprzez ułatwienie im dostępu do różnych usług takich jak biblioteki, transport, zakwaterowanie przed ich fizycznym przybyciem do zagranicznej instytucji.

d) przyjazne dla użytkownika platformy internetowe i narzędzia do współpracy wirtualnej, w tym usługi wspierające program eTwinning i ePlatformę na rzecz uczenia się dorosłych w Europie oraz narzędzia ułatwiające mobilność edukacyjną, w tym inicjatywa dotycząca europejskiej karty studenta.

The European Student Card (ESC)

Simplifying student mobility

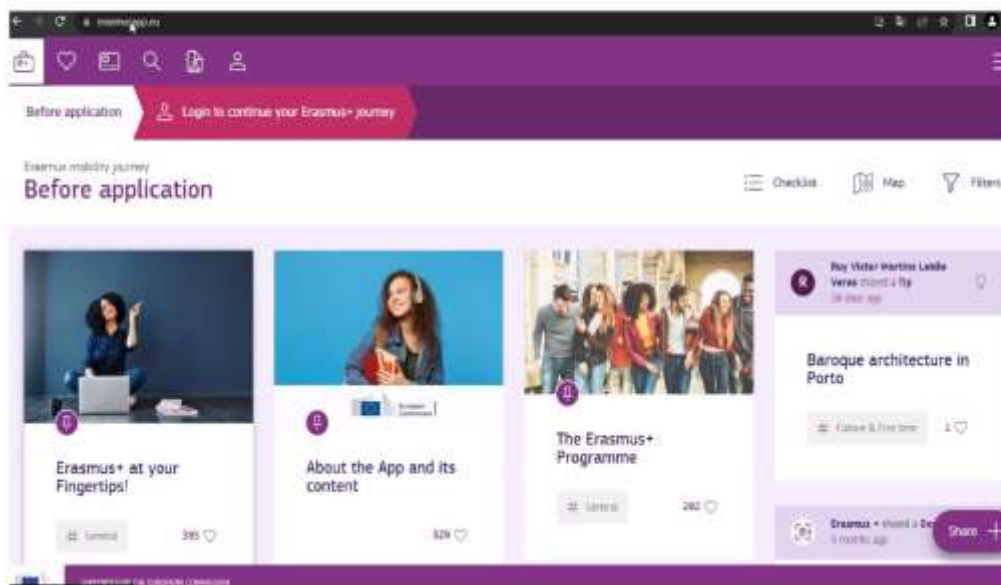
The European Student Card (ESC) simplifies student mobility in Europe. It enables higher education institutions to seamlessly and reliably verify a student's status at European level.

By joining the ESC system and building upon existing physical or digital student cards, higher education institutions can centralise specific student card data, cut paperwork and promote green and digital transition.

Students travelling across Europe for their education will get easier access to services - both on and off campus - offered by their host institution. This means a better, more connected mobility experience and a sense of belonging to the European higher education community.

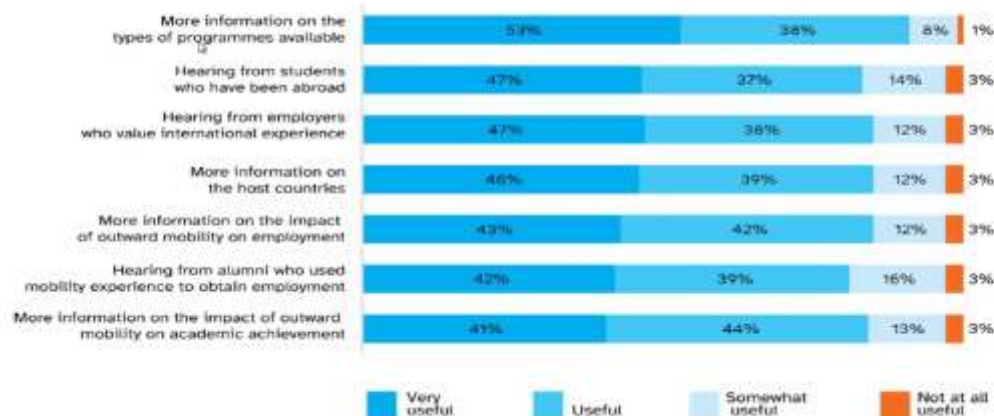

Erasmus Without Paper EWP

Erasmus Without Paper (EWP) initiative aim to pave the way for Erasmus coordinators to manage mobilities more efficiently by replacing paper exchanges by data exchanges between IT-systems. Erasmus Without Paper has two components, a network and the Erasmus Dashboard.



EWP Network

- Interconnects a multitude of student information systems whether individual universities or third-party providers which represent multiple institutions through the use of APIs (i.e. connectors between the Network and the users)



eduGAIN

eduGAIN is an international interfederation service interconnecting research and education identity federations. It enables the secure exchange of information related to identity, authentication and authorization between participating federations. The service is managed by a team led by TERENA. eduGAIN® is a registered trademark of DANTE.

The eduGAIN service enables participating federations, which primarily serve the authentication and authorisation interests of research and education sectors, to interfederate. eduGAIN provides an infrastructure for establishing trusted communications between identity providers and service providers in different participating federations. End-users authenticate at identity providers and obtain access to service providers. Technically eduGAIN is managed by aggregating and distributing signed SAML 2.0 metadata files. 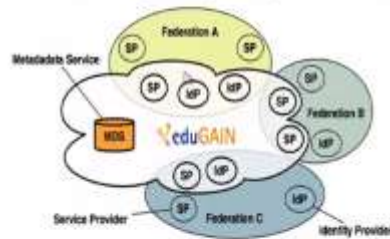


eduGAIN

Interfederation: exchanging metadata

eduGAIN is a form of interfederation. Participating federations share information (metadata) about entities from their own federation with eduGAIN. Next, eduGAIN bundles these metadata and publishes it on a central location. All participating federations now have a single location to find information about entities from other federations. Thanks to this information, Identity Providers and Service Providers from different federations can now connect to each other.

With interfederation, it's no longer necessary for entities to join each others' federation when they want to connect to each other.



eduGAIN aggregates metadata from participating federations (metadata service). This aggregate is consumed by all participating federations, such that Identity Providers and Service Providers can find each other.

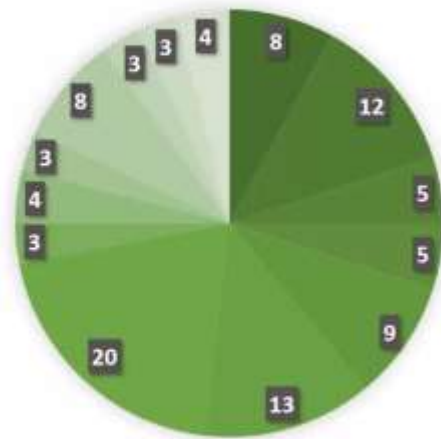

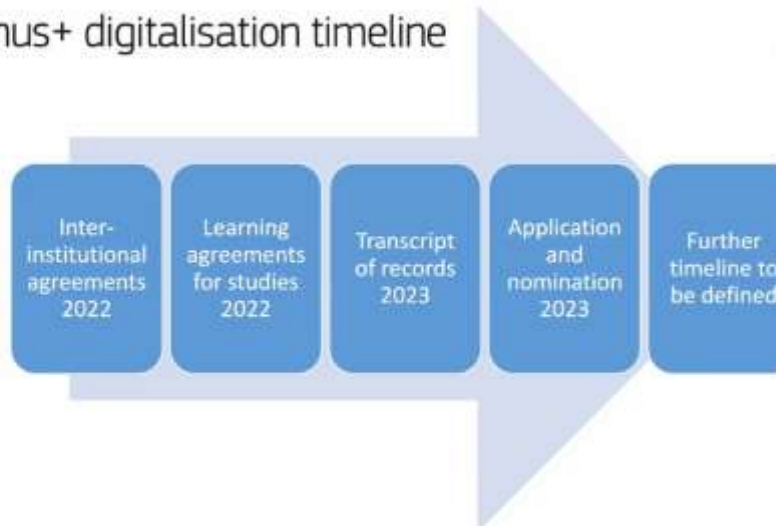
